










The Foundation is a family affair

Make Sure You Get Your







- Let Macy and the San Diego Foundation know if you change your preferred <u>email</u> <u>address</u>.
- Establish a relationship with an on-campus student mentor by this October.
- Return your SDF <u>paperwork</u> well before the twice yearly deadline, which you will find in the paperwork emailed from SDF (and don't forget to include a newsy <u>thank-you letter</u>).
- Maintain <u>full-time</u> student status (12 units).
- Keep a GPA of 2.0 as a freshman and sophomore, and 3.0 as a junior and a senior.
- Please note:
 - Your money goes directly to your college account. You'll see it posted there.
 - You have a four-year scholarship, but the years do NOT have to be consecutive.
 - If your GPA does drop below the minimum, you can apply for a waiver. And you definitely should, because we want all our scholar to succeed. (Contact SDF for the appeal paperwork.)

Mentors are important to success.

Our scholarship requires you have two:

College Mentor

A person you find at college early in your freshman year. Someone who understands the challenges of being First Gen, who you meet with monthly to discuss school and life.

Board Mentor

A member of the Weil Family Foundation Board (Chris, Pat, Matt, Kit, Caitlin or Macy) who will reach out to you by email twice a year to see how you are, and to whom you can reach out any time you like!
